 - i. Found out end of day Thurs about new division
 - ii. Teachers needed to organize

 - iv. Extra time at the outset can save challenges later. Can't move children after they have been in classes

 - v. Responded to questions about how to communicate that out to parents in a more timely manner reviewing this process as recognize that some families may have been expecting children to be home by a certain time
